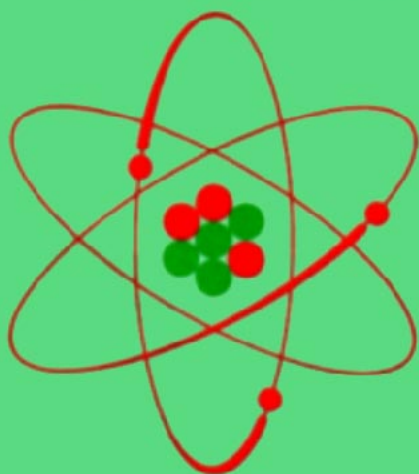


# THE ILLUSTRATED STORY OF THE ATOM BOMB

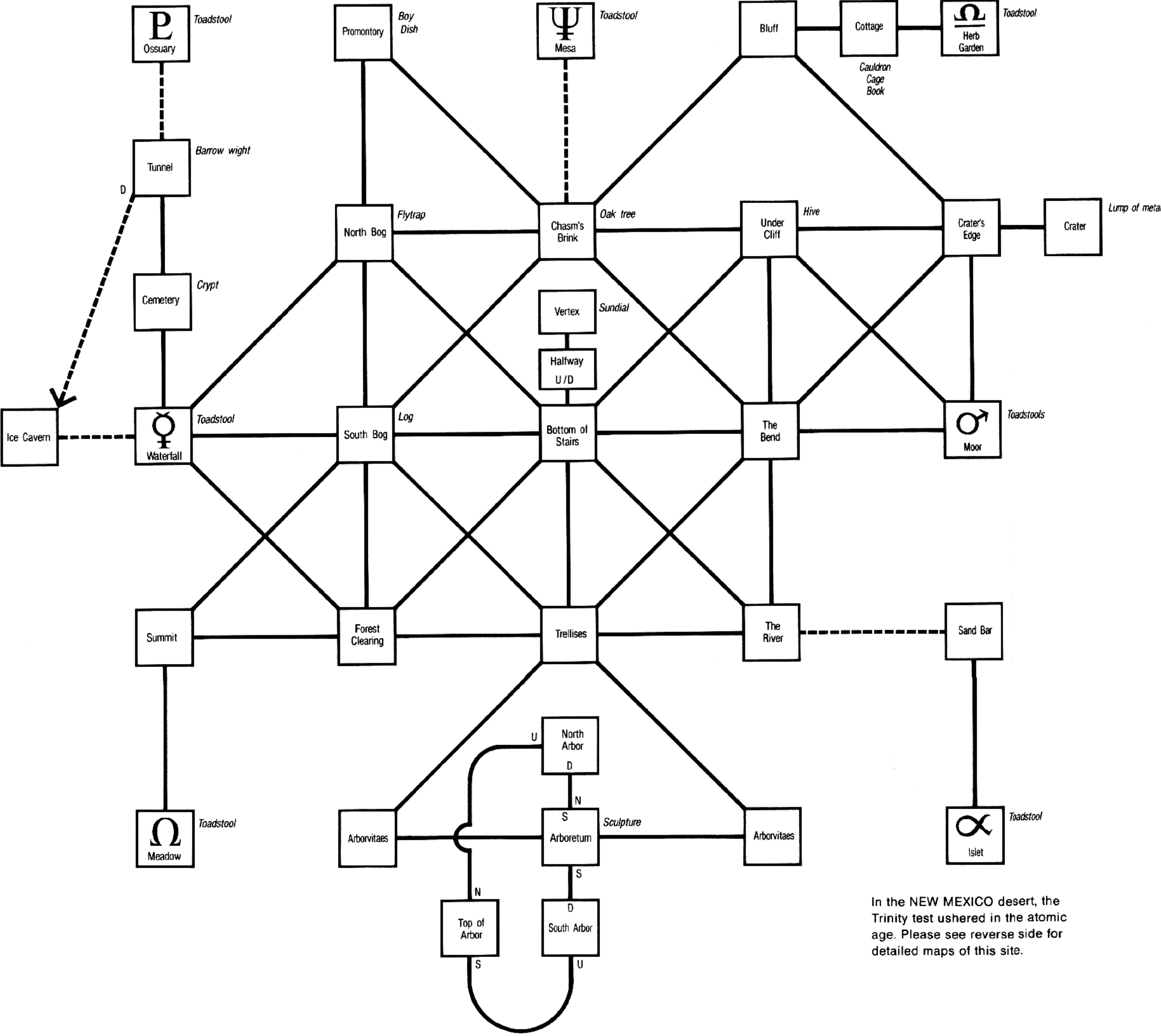

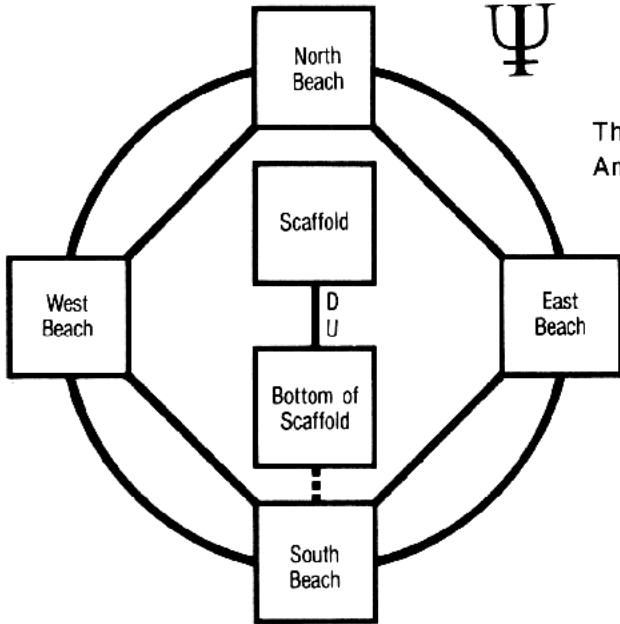

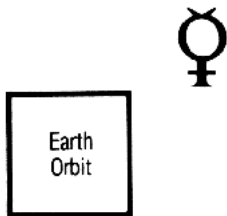


In the NEW MEXICO desert, the Trinity test ushered in the atomic age. Please see reverse side for detailed maps of this site.



The Eniwetok ATOLL was the site of America's first H-bomb explosion.

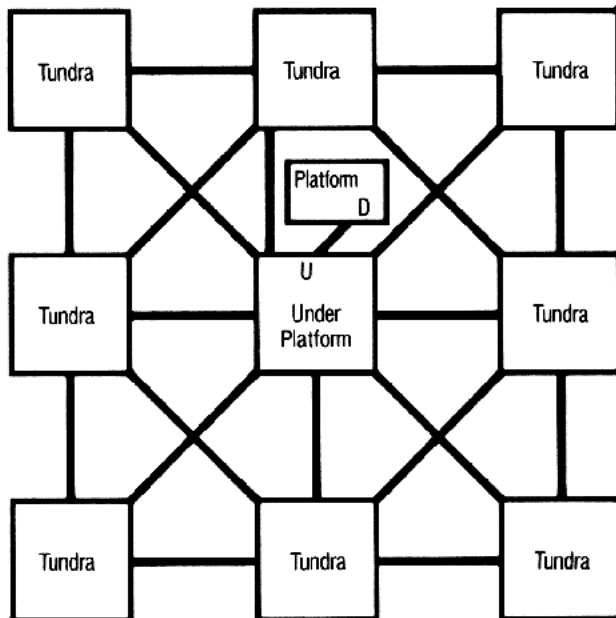




In the depths of OUTER SPACE, an orbiting "umbrella" of high technology defends the Free World from nuclear attacks.

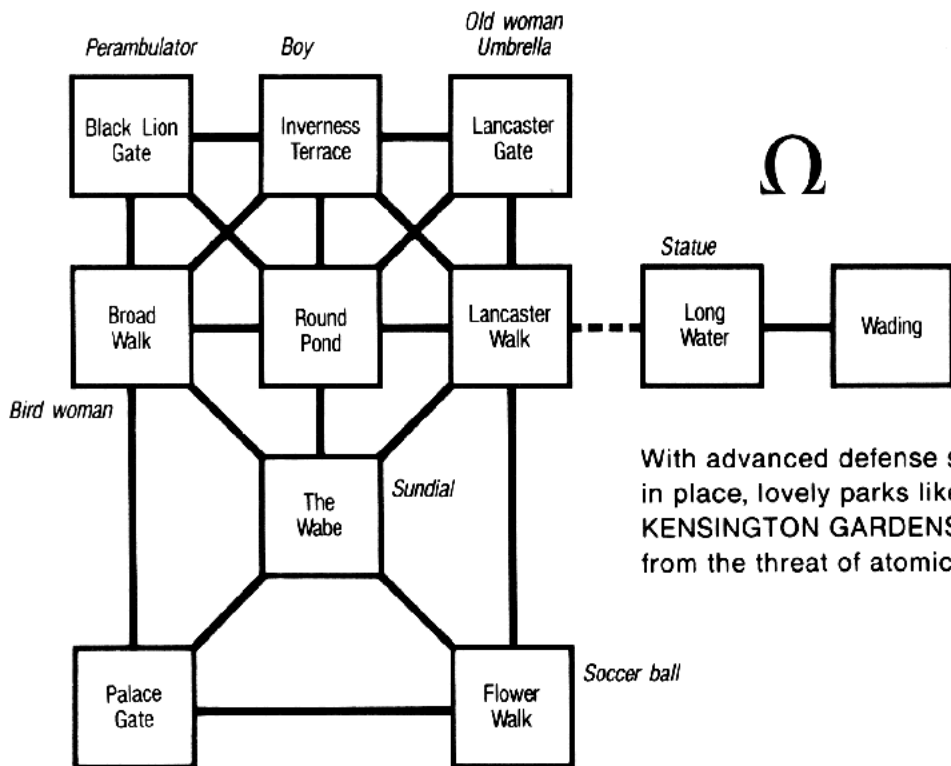

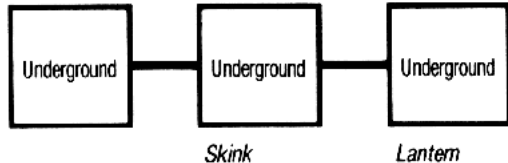
In the wastelands of **SIBERIA**, the Russians build and test their own atomic weapons.



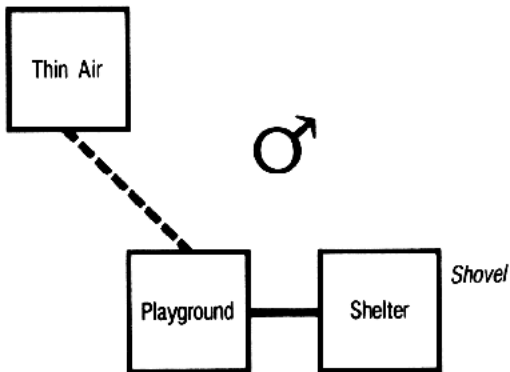

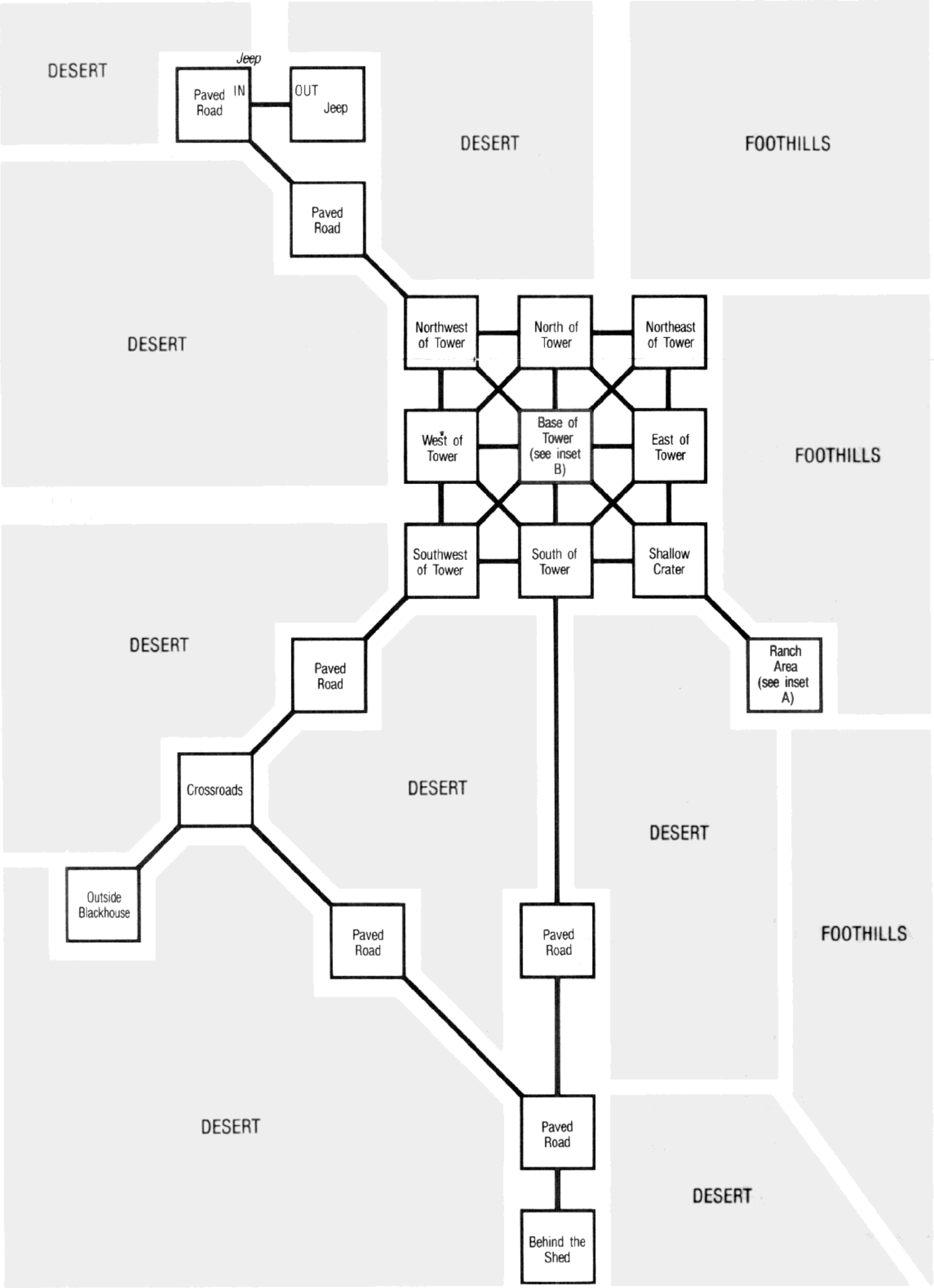


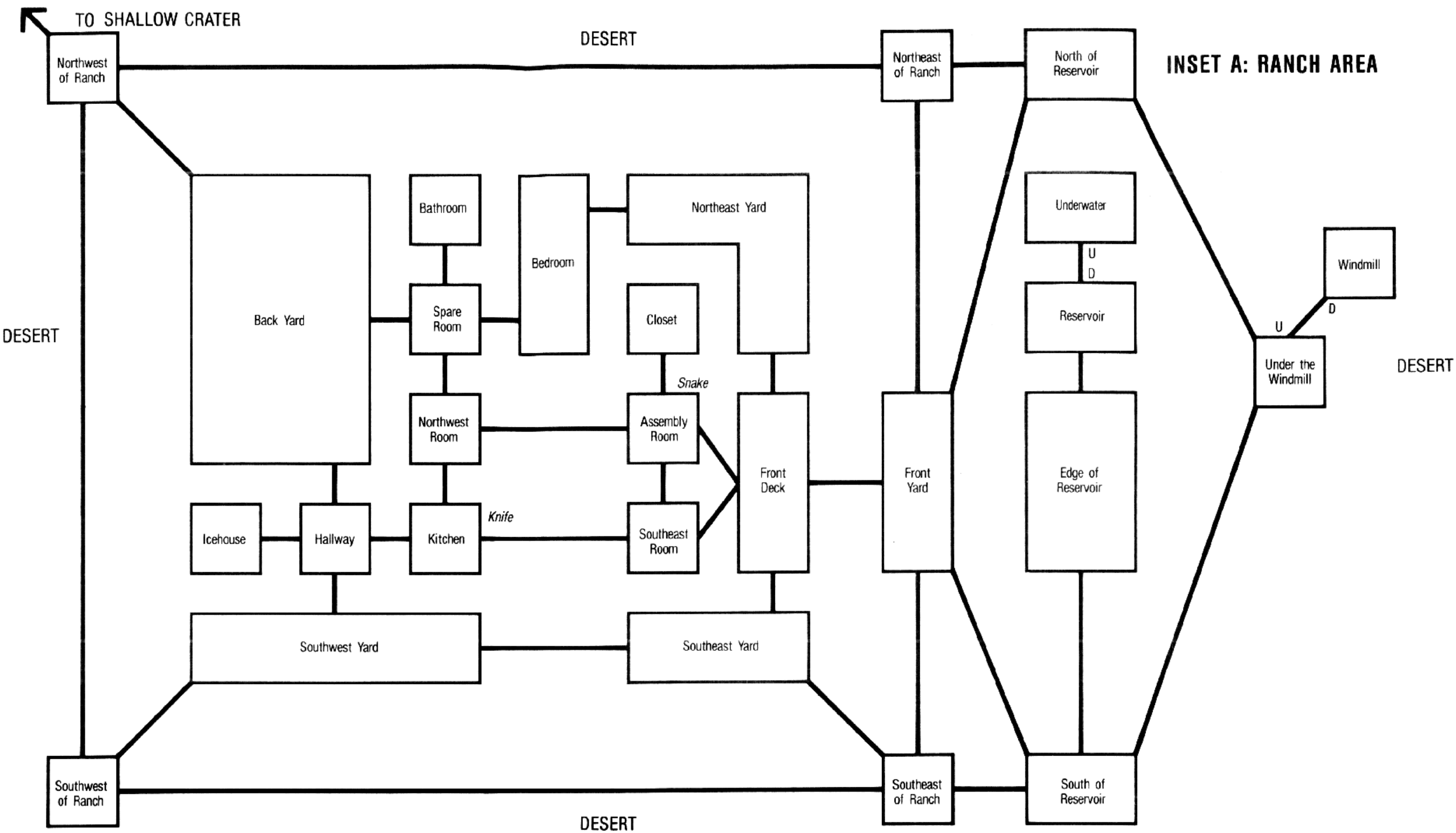


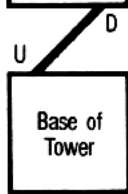
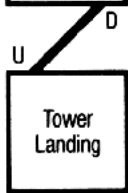
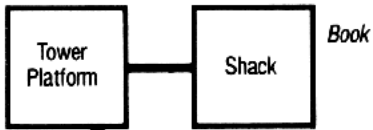


The bombing of the Japanese city of NAGASAKI brought World War II to an end.

The first atomic bomb was built and detonated at this site in the NEW MEXICO desert. A 100-foot steel tower was erected for the test (see map above right). Final assembly of the bomb took place in the nearby ranch house (see map to the left).
